

MyEternal Life

John

1:4 In Him *is my* life, and *this* life *is* the light of men.

3:15 . . . *if I believe* in Him *I will* not perish, but have eternal life.

16 For God *loved me so much*, that He gave His one and only Son, *so that if I would believe* in Him *I would* not perish, but have eternal life.

3:36 *I believe* in the Son *and have* eternal life, but one who disobeys the Son won't see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

4:14 *but if I drink* the water that *He gives me* *I will* never thirst again; the water that *He gives me* will become in *me* a well of water springing up to eternal life.

5:21 For as *my* Father raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son also gives *me* life.

5:24 *Jesus assured me if I hear His* word, and *believe* Him who sent *Him*, *I have* eternal life, and *don't* come into judgment, but *have* passed out of death into life.

(John continued)

5:25 Most certainly, *He told me*, the hour comes, and now is, when the dead will hear the Son of God's voice; and those who hear will live.

26 For as *my* Father has life in Himself, even so He gave to the Son also to have life in Himself.

6:33 For the bread of God is that which comes down out of heaven *to me*, and gives life to the world.

6:35 Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life." *If I come to Him I will not be hungry, and if I believe in Him I will never be thirsty.*

6:40 This is the will of the One who sent *Him*, that *when I see* the Son, and *believe* in Him, *I will* have eternal life; and *He* will raise *me* up at the last day.

6:47 Most certainly, *He told me, if I believe in Him I have* eternal life.

48 *He is* the bread of life.

6:51 *He is* the living bread which came down out of heaven. *If I eat* of this bread, *I will* live forever. Yes, the bread which *He gives* for *my* life *is His* flesh.

6:53 Jesus *said . . . unless I eat* the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, *I don't* have life in *myself*.

54 *If I eat His* flesh and *drink His* blood *I have* eternal life, and *He* will raise *me* up at the last day.

(John continued)

6:56 *If I eat His flesh and drink His blood I live in Him, and He lives in me.*

57 As the living Father sent *Him*, and *He lives* because of the Father; so as *I feed on Him*, I will also live because of *Him*.

6:63 It is the Spirit who gives life. *My flesh profits nothing. The words that He speaks to me are spirit, and are life.*

7:38 *If I believe in Him*, as the Scripture has said, from within *me* will flow rivers of living water.

8:12 Again, therefore, Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world." *If I follow Him I will not walk in the darkness, but I will have the light of life.*

10:10 The thief only comes to steal, kill, and destroy. *Jesus came so I could have life, and have it abundantly.*

10:28 *He gave eternal life to me. I will never perish, and no one will snatch me out of His hand.*

11:25 Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life." *If I believe in Him I will still live, even if I die.*

(John continued)

14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life." *I can not come* to the Father, except through *Him*.

14:19 Yet a little while, and the world will see me no more; but *I* will see *Him*. Because *He lives*, *I* will live also.

20 In that day *I* will know that *He is in our* Father, and *I'm* in *Him*, and *He's* in *me*.

17:2 even as He gave Him authority over all flesh, He will give *me* eternal life *and* all whom *the Father* has given Him.

3 This is eternal life, that *I would* know You, the only true God, and Him whom *You* sent, Jesus Christ.

20:30 Therefore Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book;

31 but these are written, that *I* may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing *I* may have life in His name.

Acts

2:28 You made known to me the ways of life. You will make me full of gladness with Your presence.

(Acts continued)

17:25 neither is He served by *my* hands, as though He needed anything, seeing He Himself gives *me* life and breath, and all things.

Romans

1:17 For in it is revealed God's righteousness from faith to faith. As it is written, *I am* righteous *and I* shall live by faith.

5:10 For if, while *I was an enemy, I was* reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, *I will be saved by His life.*

11 Not only so, but *I also rejoice in God through my* Lord Jesus Christ, through whom *I have now received the reconciliation.*

5:17 For if by the trespass of the one, death reigned through the one; so much more will *I—when I* receive the abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness reign in *my* life through the One, Jesus Christ.

18 So then as through one trespass, *I was* condemned; even so through one act of righteousness, *I was* justified to life.

(Romans continued)

5:21 that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ *my* Lord.

6:4 *I was* buried therefore with Him through baptism to death, that just like Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so *I could also* walk in newness of life.

6:8 But if *I* died with Christ, *I* believe that *I* will also live with Him;

6:11 *I* consider *myself* also to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus *my* Lord.

6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God *to me* is eternal life in Christ Jesus *my* Lord.

7:9 I was alive apart from the law once, but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.

10 The commandment, which was for life, this I found to be for death . . .

8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus made me free from the law of sin and of death.

(Romans continued)

8:6 For the mind of *my* flesh is death, but the mind of the Spirit *in me* is life and peace. . .

8:10 If Christ is in *me*, *my* body is dead because of sin, but *my* spirit is alive because of righteousness.

11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in *me*, He who raised up Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to *my* mortal *body* through His Spirit who dwells in *me*.

8:13 For if *I* live after the flesh, *I* must die; but if by the Spirit *I* put to death the deeds of the body, *I* will live.

I Corinthians

15:45 So also it is written, “The first man, Adam, became a living soul.” The last Adam became *my* life-giving spirit.

II Corinthians

2:15 For I am the sweet aroma of Christ to God, among those who are saved, and among those who perish;

(II Corinthians continued)

2:16 to the one a stench from death to death; *but to me* a sweet aroma from life to life. Who is sufficient for these things?

3:6 *He* also made *me* sufficient as *a servant* of a new covenant; not of the letter, but of the Spirit. For the letter kills, but the Spirit gives *me* life.

4:10 *I'm* always carrying in *my* body the putting to death of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in *my* body.

11 For *while I* live *I am* delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus may be revealed in *my* mortal flesh.

12 So then death works in *all*, but life in *me*.

5:4 For indeed we who are in this tent do groan, being burdened; not that *I* desire to be unclothed, but that *I* desire to be clothed, that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life.

13:4 For He was crucified through weakness, yet He lives through the power of God. For *I am also* weak in Him, but *I* will live with Him through the power of God toward *me*.

Galatians

2:19 For I, through the law, died to the law, that I might live to God.

20 I have been crucified with Christ, and it is no longer I that live, but Christ living in me. That life which I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God, who *loves me*, and gave Himself up for me.

3:21 Is the law then against the promises of God? Certainly not! For if there had been a law given which could make *me* alive, most certainly righteousness would have been of the law.

5:25 If *I* live by the Spirit, *I will* also walk by the Spirit.

6:8 For *if I sow to my own flesh I will from the flesh reap corruption*. But *if I sow to the Spirit I will from the Spirit reap eternal life*.

Ephesians

2:1 *I was* made alive when *I was* dead in transgressions and sins . . .

(Ephesians continued)

2:4 But God, being rich in mercy, for His great love with which He *loves me*,

5 even when *I was* dead through *my* trespasses, *He made me* alive together with Christ (by grace *I* have been saved) . . .

4:18 *I will not be* darkened in *my* understanding, alienated from the life of God, because of ignorance, because of the hardening of *my heart* . . .

Philippians

1:21 For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.

2:16 *I hold* up the word of life; that I may have something to boast in the day of Christ, that I didn't run in vain nor labor in vain.

Colossians

1:18 He is *my Lord and the* head of the body, the assembly, who is the Beginning, the Firstborn from the dead; that in all things He might have the preeminence.

2:13 *I was* dead through *my* trespasses and the uncircumcision of *my* flesh. He made *me* alive together with Him, having forgiven *me* all *my* trespasses . . .

3:4 When Christ, *my* life, is revealed, then *I* will also be revealed with Him in glory.

I Thessalonians

5:10 He died for *me*, that, whether *I* wake or sleep, *I will* live together with Him.

I Timothy

1:16 However, for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first, Jesus Christ might display all His patience, for an example of those who were going to believe in Him for eternal life.

6:12 *I* fight the good fight of faith. *I* lay hold of the eternal life to which *I was* called, and *I confess* the good confession in the sight of many witnesses.

6:19 laying up in store for *myself* a good foundation against the time to come, that *I* may lay hold of eternal life.

II Timothy

1:10 but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who abolished death, and brought *me* life and *my* immortality to light through the Good News.

Titus

1:2 in hope of eternal life, which God, who can't lie, promised *me* before time began . . .

3:7 that, being justified by His grace, *I am an heir* according to the hope of eternal life.

Hebrews

4:12 For the word of God is living, and active, and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing even to the dividing of *my* soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and is able to discern the thoughts and intentions of *my* heart.

10:20 by the way which He dedicated for *me*, a new and living way, through the veil, that is to say, His flesh . . .

10:38 But *I am* righteous *and* will live by faith. If *I shrink* back, *His* soul has no pleasure in *me*.

12:9 Furthermore, *I* had the *father* of *my* flesh to chasten *me*, and *I* paid *him* respect. Shall *I* not much rather be in subjection to the Father of spirits, and live?

I Peter

1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of *my* Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy became *my* Father again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead . . .

1:23 *I have* been born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, through the word of God, which lives and remains forever.

2:24 who His own self bore *my sins* in His body on the tree, that *I*, having died to sins, might live to righteousness; by whose stripes *I was* healed.

3:18 Because Christ also suffered for *my* sins once, the righteous for the unrighteous, *so* He *could* bring *me* to God; being put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit . . .

II Peter

1:4 by which He has granted to *me* His precious and exceedingly great promises; that through these *I* may become *a partaker* of the divine nature, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world by lust.

I John

3:9 *If I am* born of God *I don't* commit sin, because His seed remains in *me*; and *I can't* sin, because *I am* born of God.

3:14 *I know* that *I have* passed out of death into life, because *I love my* brothers. He who doesn't love his brother remains in death.

15 Whoever hates his brother is a murderer, and *I know* that no murderer has eternal life remaining in him.

4:7 *I am loved, and I love others*, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God, and knows God.

4:9 By this God's love was revealed in *me*, that God has sent His one and only Son into the world *so that I could* live through Him.

5:1 *If I believe* that Jesus is the Christ *I am* born of God. Whoever loves the Father also loves the child who is born of Him.

5:4 For *I am* born of God *and overcome* the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world: *my faith*.

(I John continued)

5:11 The testimony is this, that God gave *me* eternal life, and this life is in His Son.

12 *Since I have* the Son *I have* life. He who doesn't have God's Son doesn't have the life.

13 These things *were* written to *me since I* believe in the name of the Son of God, *so that I would* know that *I have* eternal life, and that *I would* continue to believe in the name of the Son of God.

5:18 *I know that since I am* born of God *I don't* sin, but *being* born of God *I keep myself*, and the evil one doesn't touch *me*.

5:20 *I know that* the Son of God has come, and has given *me* an understanding, that *I know* Him who is true, and *I am* in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

Revelation

1:5 and from Jesus Christ, the Faithful Witness, the Firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who loves *me*, and washed *me* from *my* sins by His blood . . .

2:7 *I have an ear to* hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies. To him who overcomes *He* will give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the Paradise of my God.

(Revelation continued)

3:5 *When I overcome I will be arrayed in white garments, and He will in no way blot my name out of the book of life, and He will confess my name before our Father, and before His angels.*

7:17 for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne shepherds *me*, and leads *me* to springs of waters of life. And God will wipe away every tear from *my* eyes.

21:6 He said to me, “It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. *He* will give freely to *me when I thirst* from the spring of the water of life.

22:1 He showed me a river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb,

2 in the middle of its street. On this side of the river and on that was the tree of life, bearing twelve kinds of fruits, yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

22:14 *I am blessed if I do His commandments, and I have the right to the tree of life, and may enter in by the gates into the city.*

(Revelation continued)

22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” *I hear and I say, “Come!” I am thirsty, so I come. I desire and He lets me take the water of life freely.*
